

Every two years, Toronto Pearson International Airport invites artists from the community to submit works for a juried art exhibition. For the 2013 exhibition, artists were given the theme of travel.

Response to the call to the artists was the highest since the Art and Exhibits Program launched in 2006. More than 420 works by 260 artists were submitted for consideration. The panel of three judges, drawn from the local arts community, spent most of a day reviewing the images and selected the works featured here.

One of the most interesting aspects of the review process is seeing the diversity of responses to the theme. None of the works in this exhibition is a simple document of a place. Each artist explores the idea of travel more deeply and encourages us to reflect upon our own ideas about the destination, how we get there and what we bring back with us.




